REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF ACCUMULATED DEAD SEAWEED – KATO NWANR ISLAND BASIN AT BAIE STE ANNE PRASLIN

The Seychelles Ports Authority (SPA) is inviting interested contractors to bid for the removal and disposal of accumulated dead seaweed in the Kato Nwanr Island basin at Baie Ste Anne Praslin. The service will be requested as and when the basin is full with dead seaweed to facilitate the vessels berthing and un-berthing the quay at Kato Nwanr Island.
